
Easy Instructions for Online Visa Application for Uganda

Before you begin the online application do the following:

Have the following documents handy: passport, yellow fever card, passport size photo.
 If you do not have a passport size photo, you can create one on the following State Department site:

https://travel.state.gov/content/passports/en/passports/photos/photos.html

- Take a photo of each of these documents with your smartphone and email them to yourself from your phone.
- -Download the images from your email to your computer, so you can easily attach them during the application process.
- Note: All images must be 250kb or smaller. You can adjust the image size by opening the image, exporting it as a jpg and adjusting the quality until you get under 250kb (see screenshot below.



- Jot down at minimum the last five countries you have visited. If you have visited less than five, still jot them down.
- Have one of the Uganda addresses where you will be staying handy:




Now you are ready to begin the online application:














NOTE: If you get an error stating that the site will not accept the number of days you are visiting, just retype the response to that question and try again. You may have to make three - five attempts on that question and then it just eventually accepts it. Persistence pays. If you continue to try and you cannot get it to accept the precise # of days you are staying, up the # of days by a few days and try again. When you get to Uganda, they will ask you again how many days you are staying and you can give them the correct # of days. If you purchase your visa at the airport, you will most likely be given a standard 90 day tourist stamp in exchange for your \$50, even if you are only staying for 10 days.

After clicking NEXT STEP, you will be asked to upload images of your passport bio page, yellow fever card and passport size photo. Upload these images from your computer and submit. You will then be given a confirmation # and a message that you will receive feedback via email.


You will get an email immediately stating that your application has been received. This email will also provide instructions for making an online payment of \$50 USD

Within 72 Hours you will get an email in your inbox confirming receipt of visa payment.



You will also receive a separate email confirming that your visa application has been approved. Print the attachment and present in Uganda upon arrival with your yellow fever card.
